INDIGO: What books are you looking forward to reading this fall?

ATWOOD: I'm going to the Key West Literary Seminar, so I'll be boning up on the work of the authors who are going to be there: Jennifer Egan's *A Visit from the Goon Squad*; first-time writer Charles Yu's *Third Class Superhero*, and then some old favourites: Jonathan Lethem – I will finally read *Chronicle City*, and Joyce Carol Oates – it's hard to keep up with her, and William Gibson.

INDIGO: Where is your favourite place to read?

ATWOOD: In the fall, it's in front of the fireplace, on the sofa, with a wrap, and my special reading socks which have zebra stripes on the bottom, and a cup of something.

INDIGO: You recently launched a new coffee – how did Balzac's Atwood Blend of coffee come to be?

ATWOOD: I did a bird-related book tour, which you can find at www.yearoftheflood.com, and then Ron Mann made a movie out of it. Part of the tour was emphasizing organic shade-grown coffee because it's more beneficial to birds. So Balzac's approached me and said, "Can we name a coffee after you and give \$1/bag to a bird organization and 25¢ to The Smithsonian, because they do the certification?" And I said, 'how can I say no.'

INDIGO: How do you take your coffee?

ATWOOD: With cream or steamed milk, or sometimes I have an espresso. Of course, it depends what country you're in. I'm old enough to remember when the waiters in Paris would come to your table and pour the coffee from a great height, and at the same time, they'd pour the hot milk, and the two streams would meet right above your cup. It was an art form. You'd order it just to see them do it.

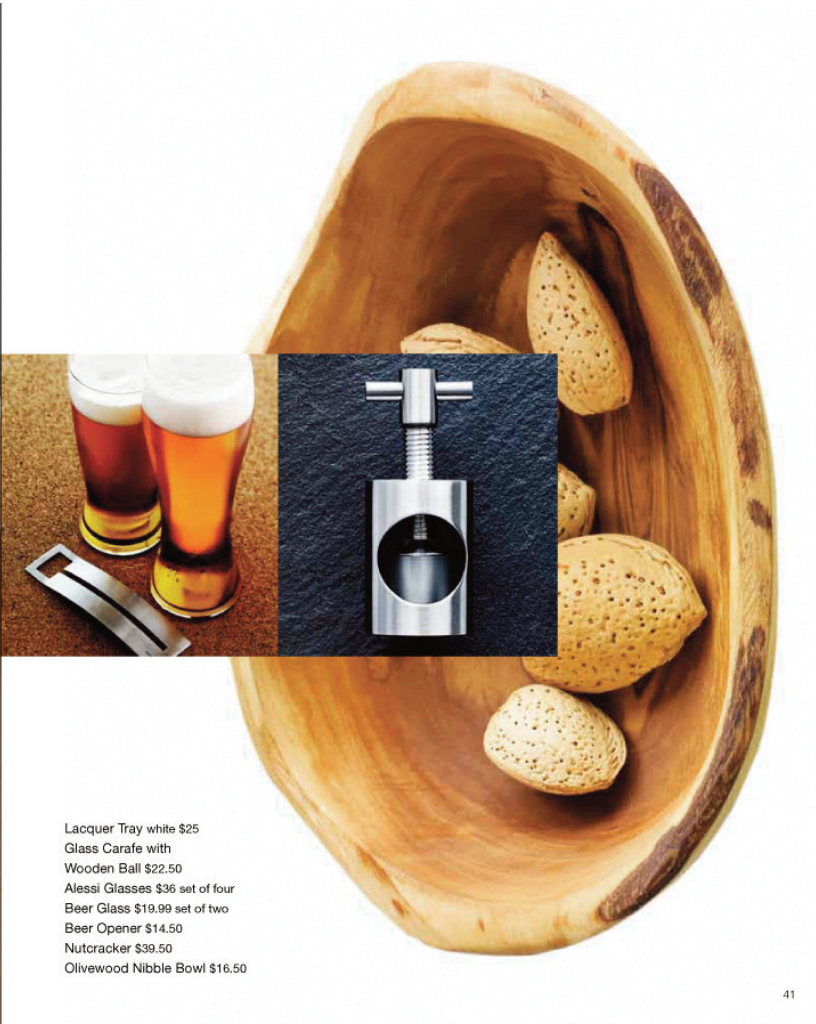

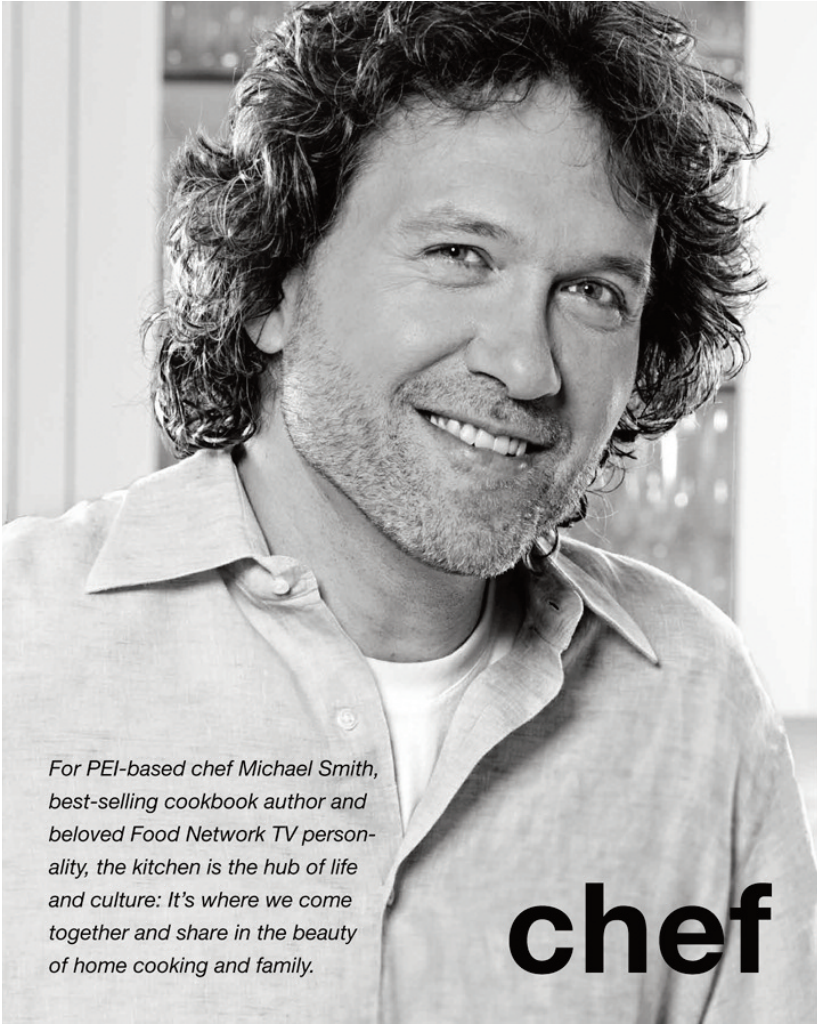

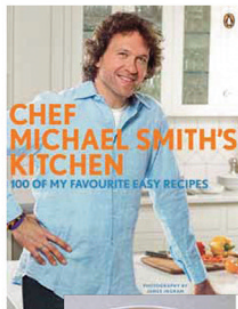

INDIGO: Chef Michael Smith's *Kitchen: 100 of My Favourite Easy Recipes* (Penguin, \$32) is full of rustic and cozy recipes and pictures. How intentional was that comfort theme?

SMITH: It was intentional and unintentional at the same time because fundamentally, everything I do centres on my home kitchen and the energy of that kitchen. It just flows from that.

INDIGO: How many cookbooks do you own and what's your no.1?

SMITH: There are hundreds around, but my go-to reference is *The Joy of Cooking*. I got my first one from my mom, and I have 5 of them; I've worn out 4.

INDIGO: What's your advice for those who feel they're too busy to cook?

SMITH: I have hard and soft advice. For the soft, it's relax. Perfection is not the goal when you're cooking; just being present and relaxing and enjoying yourself and getting dinner on the table is the goal. The hard advice: Suck it up. It's a dramatic mistake that we allow ourselves to believe we're too busy to do what human beings have done for hundreds of thousands of years. Get your priorities straight: There's nothing more important than spending time with your family and the most powerful way to do that is with food at your table, every day – every single day.

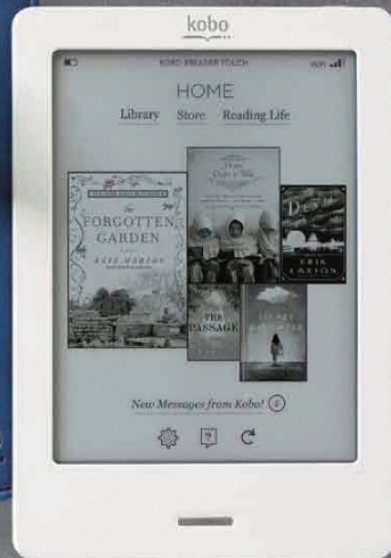
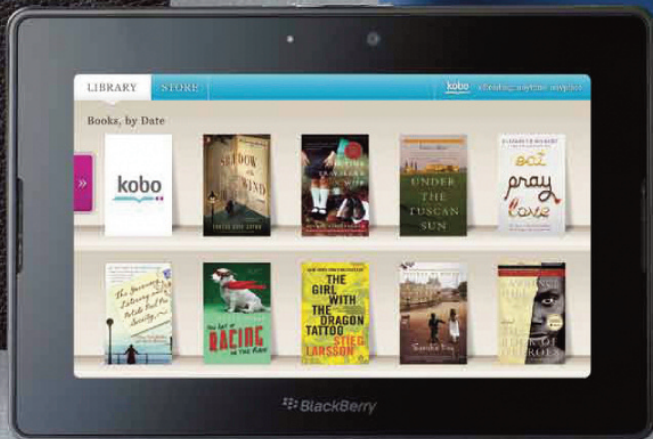
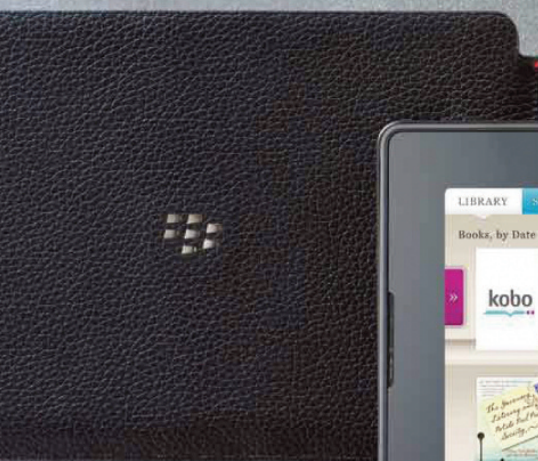

Indigo: What was your favourite dinner growing up?

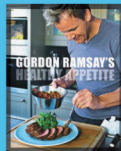
